






Latest Records & Highlights

SPGFD Phase 12 - Operational Highlights

- 2.2% increase in GDP
- 15% increase in gas production in Iran
- 17% increase in gas condensate production in Iran
- Commissioning of 6 Gas Treatment Units (GTU) in less than 11 months
- Involvement of more than 145 million man/hour of work
- Drilling the deepest gas well with the depth of 5,311 meters



Latest Records & Highlights

SPGFD Phase 12 - Operational Highlights

- Record of 64.7 million man/hour of safe work (without any incident)
- Having more than 2,000 days without any incident in drilling operations
- Managing 17,000 workforce in the peak of execution phase in Offshore, Onshore and Drilling sections
- Managing more than 560 domestic and foreign contractors and vendors for providing equipment required for the Project
- Record of the fastest drilling operation in 24" section in the South Pars gas field
